


Vegetables (Mustard, *Brassica juncea*) growing well in the aquaponic system at the Bunda farm. Two ways of production systems were tested; floating and with gravels. In an advanced stage, gravels were replaced with clay pebbles.



Floating seedlings; the roots are retrieving the nutrients straight out of the water.



Substrates are fundamental components for aquaponics because they act as a small reservoir of nutrients.




Due to unavailability of industrially produced clay pebbles the project established a small production in Malawi.

For the mass production of the clay pebbles, folks from the local communities were hired.

A kiln was build from the project in order to bake the clay pebbles

A selection of well-grown Tilapia specimen.






The nets are considered a treasure in the fish clubs and carefully treated. The farmer carry together the net to the next pond to continue harvesting fish.

Watering the acres with pond water allows production of vegetables even in the dry season and with less artificial fertilizers.




This farmer showing proudly his plantations (Mustard leaves) at the end of the dry season.
